Representative



As a **Kentucky State Representative** I meet with the people in my district and take their needs to the **House of Representatives**. It is my job to make things better for the people in my area.



After I know what the people want, I go before the House made up of **100** other Representatives from other districts to convince them to vote for what the people in my district want.

Senate



As a **Senator** I ask for **laws** to be made. Then convince other Senators to vote for my **laws** or **bills**. There are **38** Senators. Then After careful consideration everyone votes. Both branches (**House of Representatives and The Senate**) must vote for most Laws. Both make up the **Legislative Branch**.

Judges are elected to a term of 4 – 8 years. There are 4 types of judges in the **Commonwealth of Kentucky**. The **Supreme Court** Judge is the highest. It is the Judges job to look at all the laws and make sure they are fair.

The head of the Executive Branch is the Governor. It is his job to carry out and enforce the laws.

This Branch has several departments that oversee particular areas.

All of these departments make up the Executive Branch.
